GROOMED SKI TRAILS DISTANCE

Big Dam

- 1. Big Dam Road 6.4 km return
- 2. Big Dam Road 8.0 km return
(Incl. Flowing Waters Trail)

Peskowesk

- 3. Grafton Lake to Gold Mines 7.0 km return
- 4. Grafton Lake to Eel Weir 16.0 km return
- 5. Grafton Lake to Peskowesk 30.0 km return

Trails are groomed on weekends from January to March.

When snowshoeing or hiking on trails, please keep to the side of the ski tracks. Snowshoeing is permitted on un-groomed trails
